

DIFFUSERS



If you don't like the glare of light bulbs then a lampshade diffuser is what you need. A diffuser is designed to sit in the bottom of a ceiling pendant light shade or the top of table or floor lamps to distract your eye from the light bulb. A lampshade diffuser is most useful when you have a larger ceiling shade, as the diameter is much wider and therefore the light bulb is easier to see.

Firstly you need to decide how much light you want in the room. The type of diffuser and what material it is made out of will determine how much light will be let out of the shade. Lampshade diffusers are laser cut to ensure a perfect fitting to your lampshades. Once your lampshade has been fitted simply pop the diffuser into your shade and slide it into place so that it sits just above the bottom ring. The beautiful thing about diffusers are that you can swap and change them very easily without changing your existing shade as you often as you wish to suit different times of year and your décor.



You can choose from opal acrylic, frosted acrylic, cotton or we are of course happy to use many other fabrics including customers own but will need to discuss fabric suitability and quantity required. Opal acrylic is white in tone and is produced specifically to diffract and diffuse light when used on a shade. Frosted diffusers are also made with opal acrylic, it is white in tone and is produced specifically to create a softer more elegant light. You can choose from 75 cotton colours to diffuse your shade to create a semi-opaque diffuser, perfect for disguising the glare of a lamp.
